Applying Slide Transition to your Slides

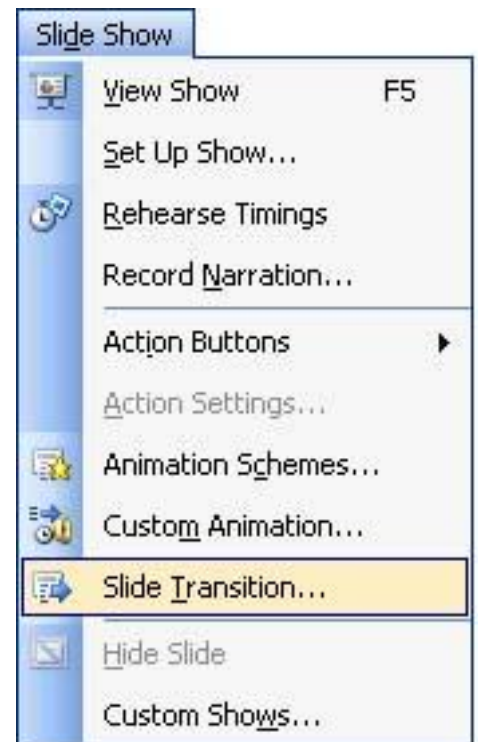
PowerPoint Transition effects provide a delight for the eyes while viewing a presentation in its entirety. PowerPoint offers 19 different transition effects which can be applied to each slide. Lets have a look at the different options which are available while viewing slides.

1. Click **Slide Show** on the Menu Bar, select on **Slide Transition**
2. The Slide Transition dialog window appears, use **the drop-down box** to select **Random Transition**.



3. Select **Medium** for speed of transition.
4. Make sure the box **On Mouse Click** is **selected**.
5. If you want to add a sound to the transition, click the sound drop-down box and select the sound you want to apply.
6. Click the **Apply to All Slides** button to apply to all slides in the presentation

7. If you **switch to Slide Show View**, you will be able to view the transition effects you have just applied to all the slides in your presentation. **Close and Save**



Applying Timing to your Slide Transition

1. Adding timing to your current transition effects is as easy as clicking the **"Automatically after"** box (in the slide transition screen above) and then entering a time you want your slides to progress after.
2. For this exercise, we will **enter 40 seconds** (eg 00:40)
3. **Switch to Slide Sorter View** and **view the addition of the transition effects and timing** which have been added underneath each slide
4. Different Timing settings can be applied to different slides. To apply a different setting to a single slide, set your transition timing and then click on Apply for the current slide only.

Text Animation

Animating your Text

Sometimes when the presenter is talking to the audience through a series of points, it is handy to have each bullet point appear when it is addressed by the speaker. In an instance like this, the speaker would animate his text to be activated upon mouse click or even after a certain amount of time. Lets look at how this can be set up.

AutoPreview

1. Click onto the item in your slide you wish to Animate.
2. Now Go to **Slide Show** on the Menu Bar, select **Custom Animation**.
3. The Custom Animation dialog panel appears as pictured here.
4. Once you have selected your item you want to animate, whether it be an image or text or WordArt etc... Click onto the **Add Effect** button
5. Choose the desired effect you want from the effect options listed
6. In the **Start** dropdown box, in the select your timing option from: **On Click, With Previous** or **After Previous**
7. Next choose the **Direction** you want the effect to occur in
8. Now select the how fast you want the effect to happen by choosing the **Speed** dropdown box
9. When you have finished selecting all the effects and the way they react with each other and your item you have chosen to animate, click "**Play**" button to preview your entire effect you have added.
